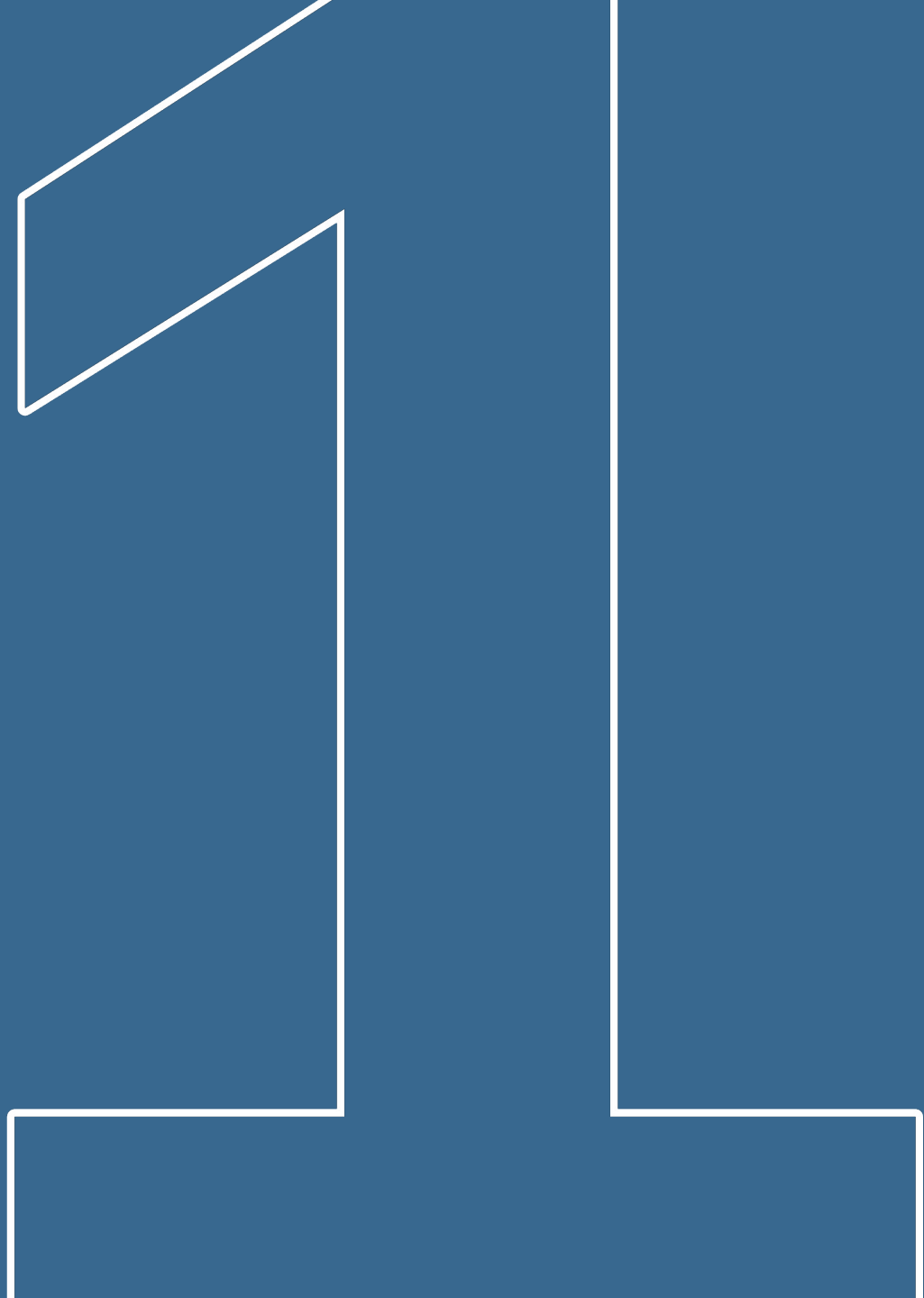

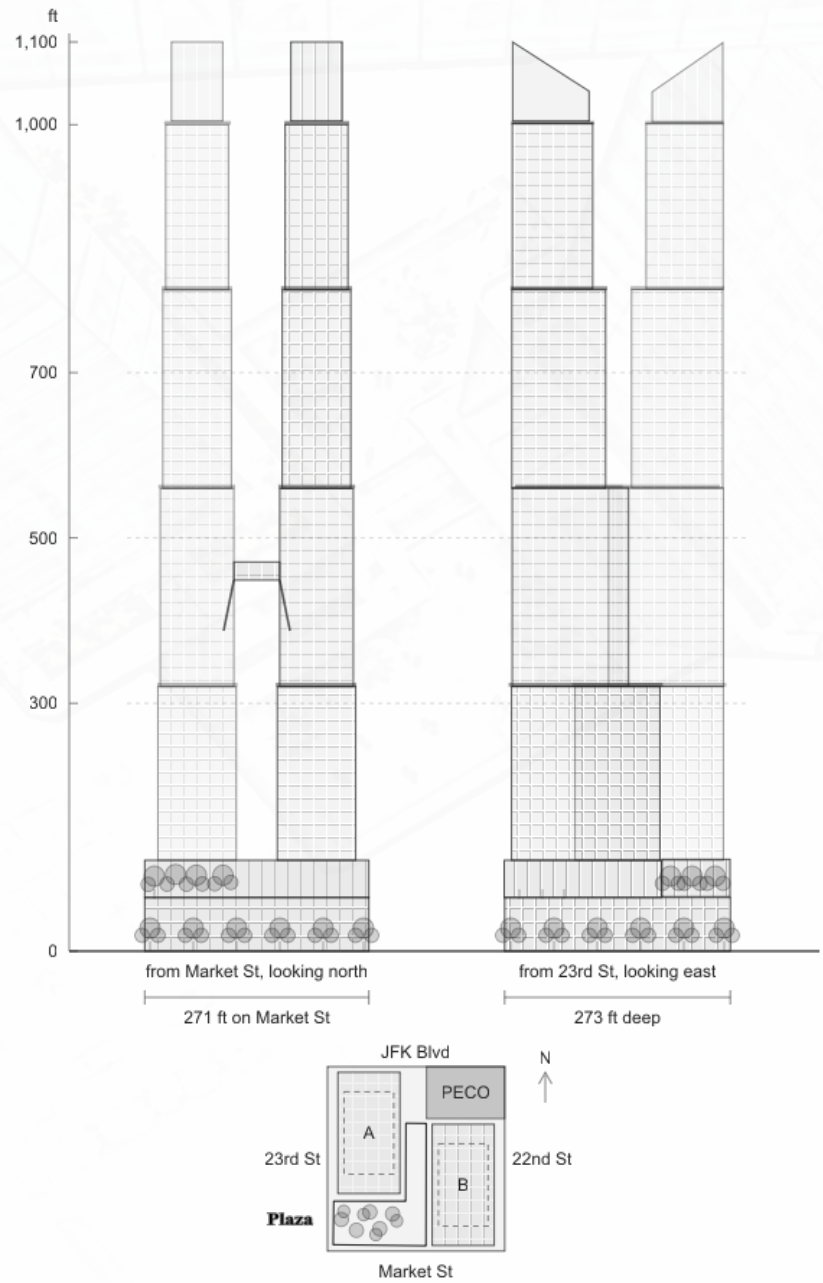


The Initial Sketch

Original concept drawing

A paired silhouette, stepped sections and a shared civic base establish the project's first architectural idea.

Contrary to this sketch, the current design rotates the pair together while retaining their stagger and shared base. The generational theme remains at its center.

2 Towers

A pair with opposing crowns.

Rising 1,085 ft / 330.7 m

Roofline 985 ft / 300.2 m; Crown rises 100 ft / 30.5 m above roofline.

Mixed Use

Recreation, sky gardens and observation decks.
Public gathering at Millennium Plaza and above.

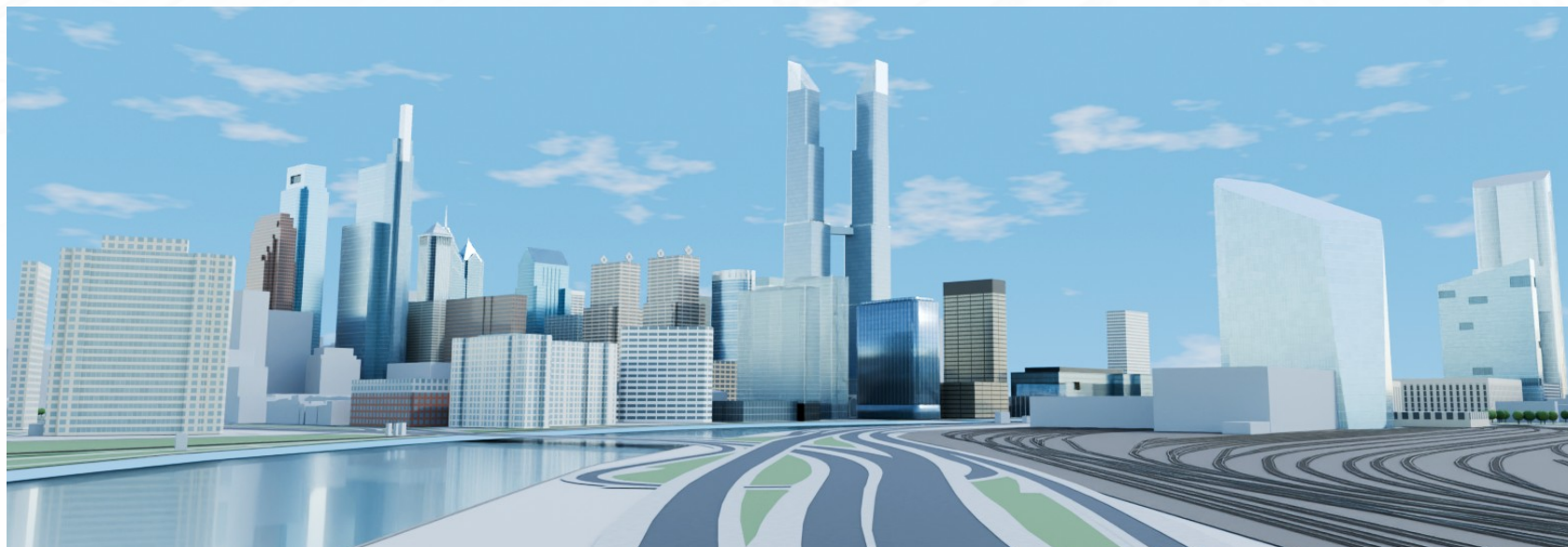

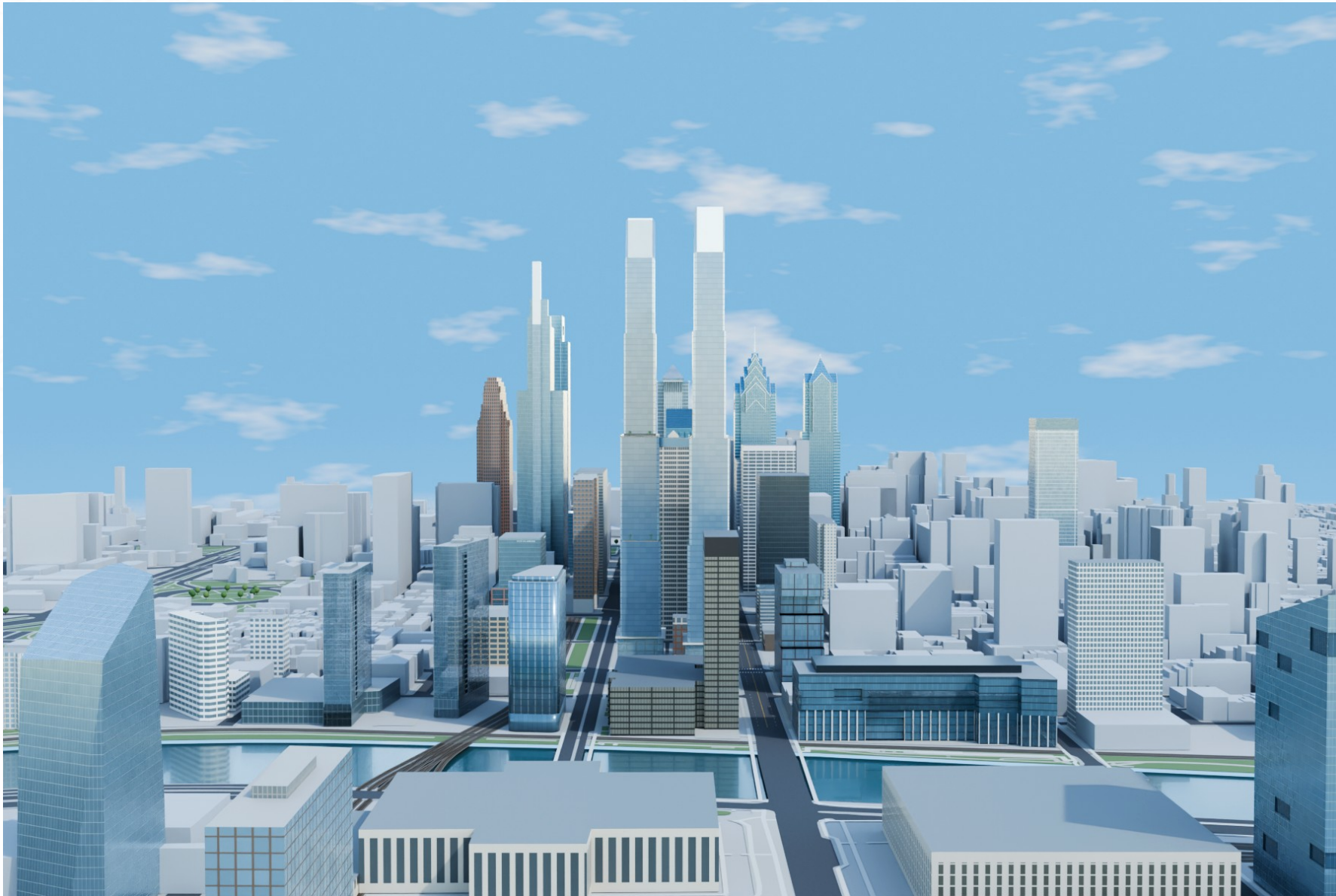
A new horizon for Philadelphia

The site sits near the Schuylkill crossing between Center City and University City, with 30th Street Station across the river. That position inspired the proposal: a substantial addition to the skyline at a place that already connects different parts of Philadelphia.

Philadelphia helped establish a nation and served as its capital. The anniversary invites a question alongside remembrance: what can the next generation bring?

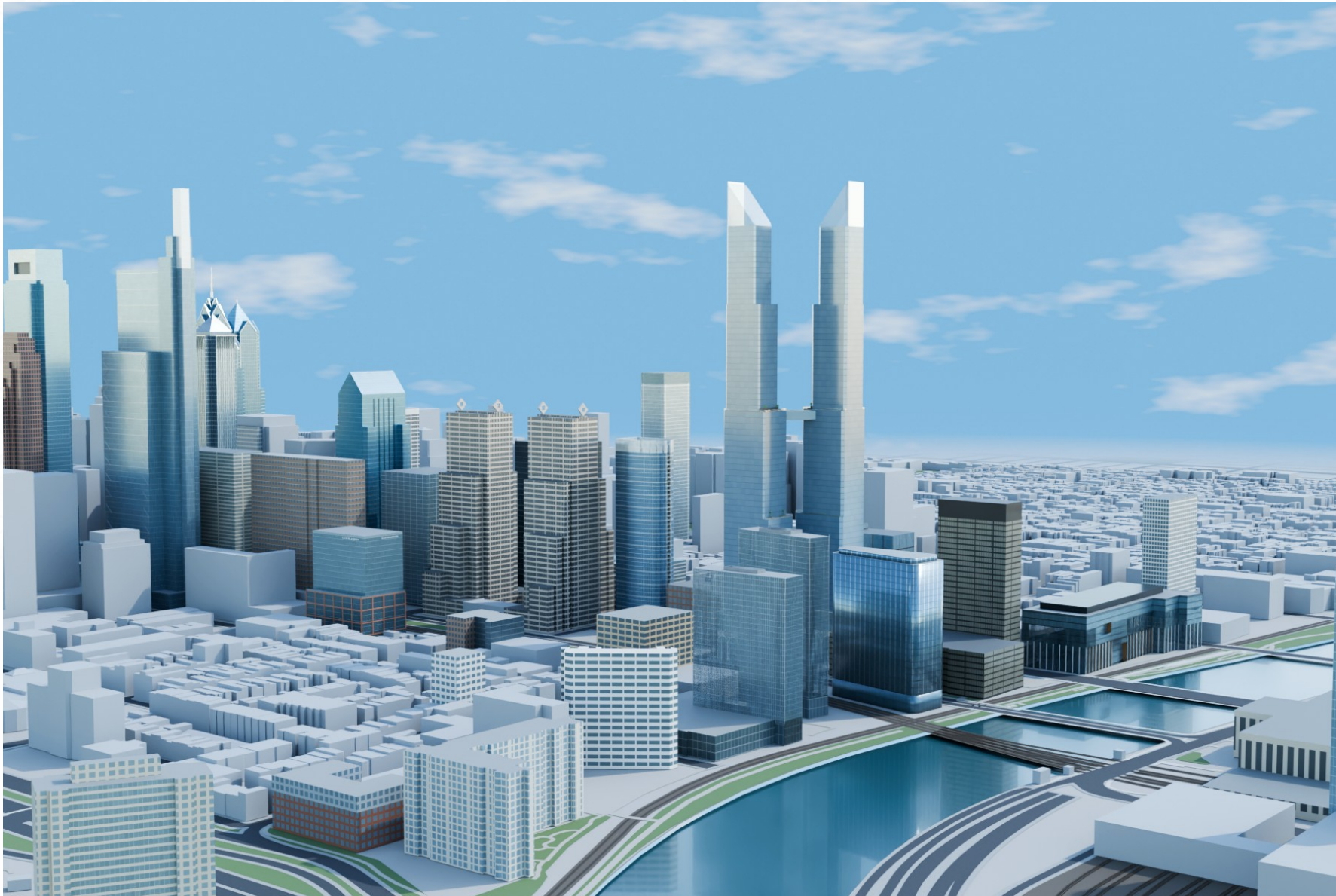
For Bridge, these towers express confidence in the city's capacity for growth, a bold proposal to draw attention, start conversations, and invite people to see new possibilities.

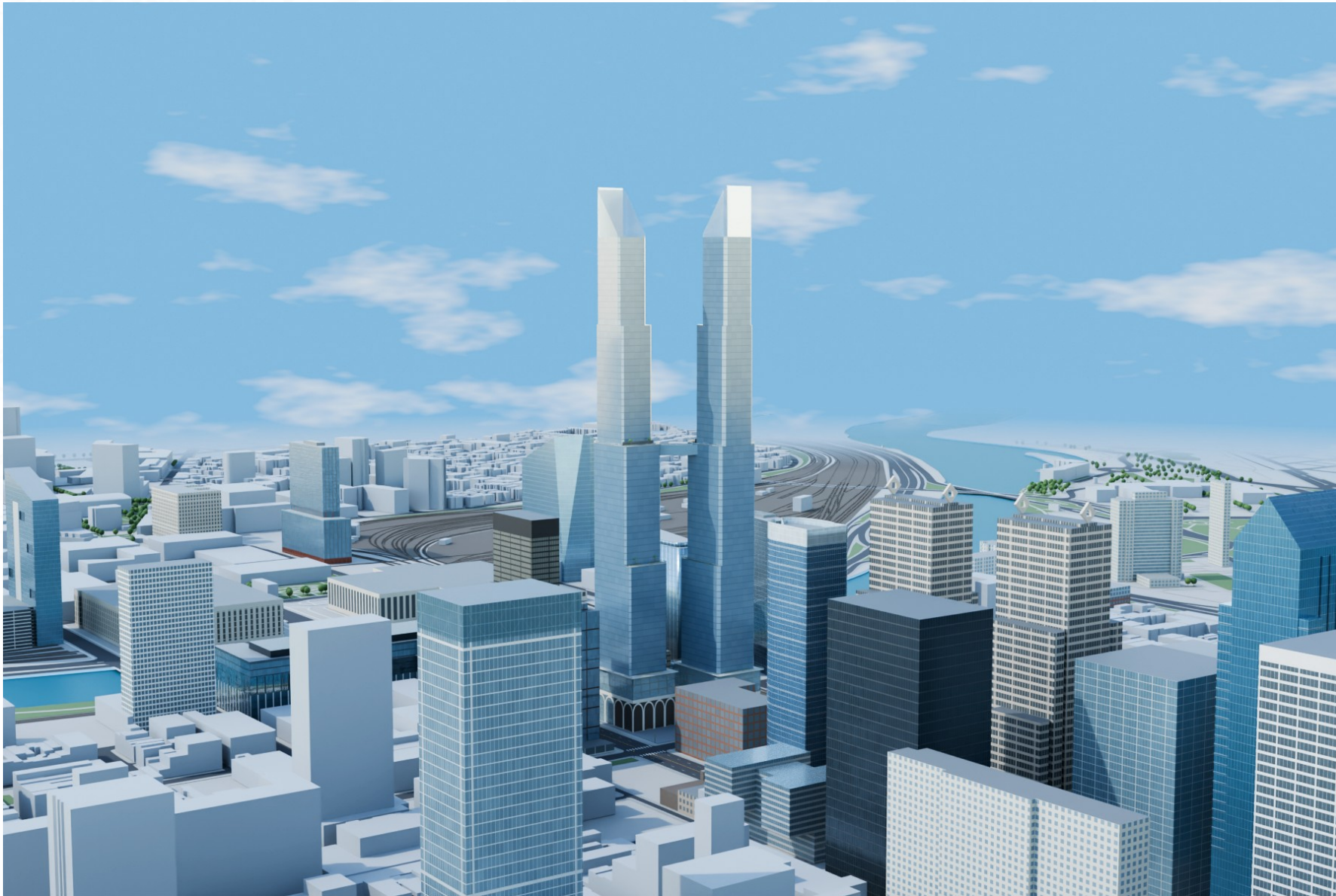
The proposed anchor pair stands tall near the Schuylkill crossing, between Center City and University City.

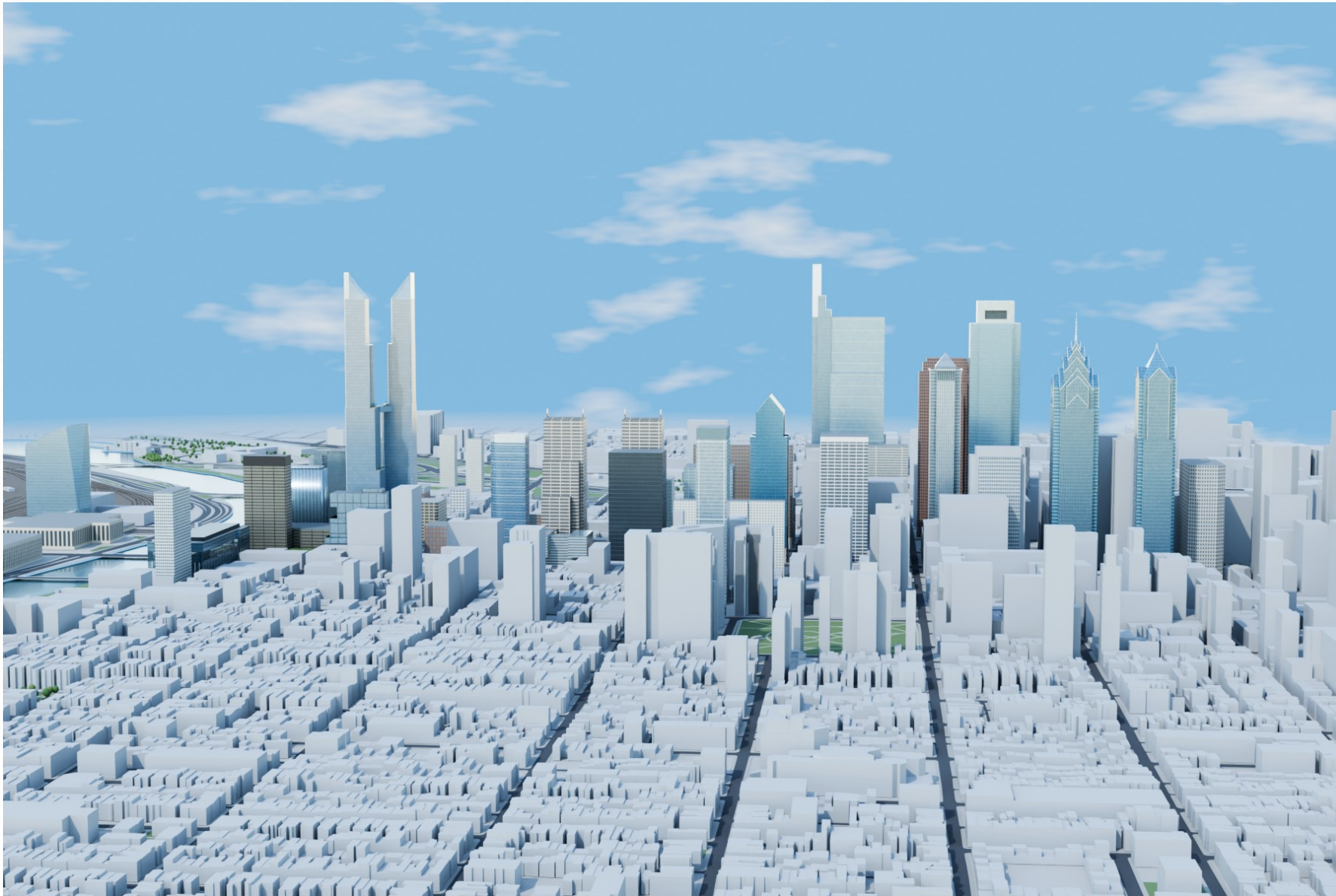
Stepped forms and opposing crowns give the two towers a distinct identity within the western skyline.

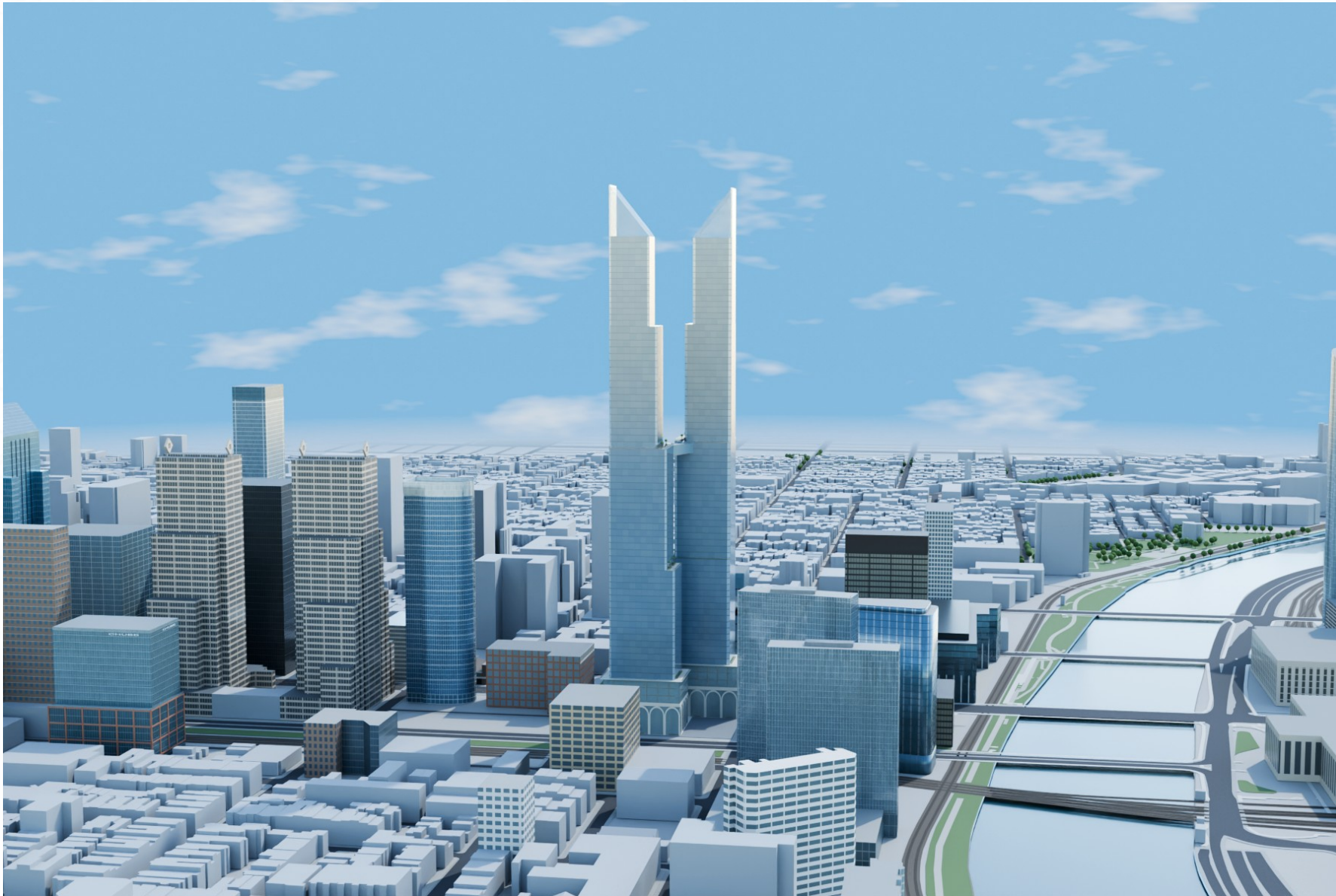
The wider skyline places the twin towers within Philadelphia's existing cluster of landmarks, increasing overall density and height.

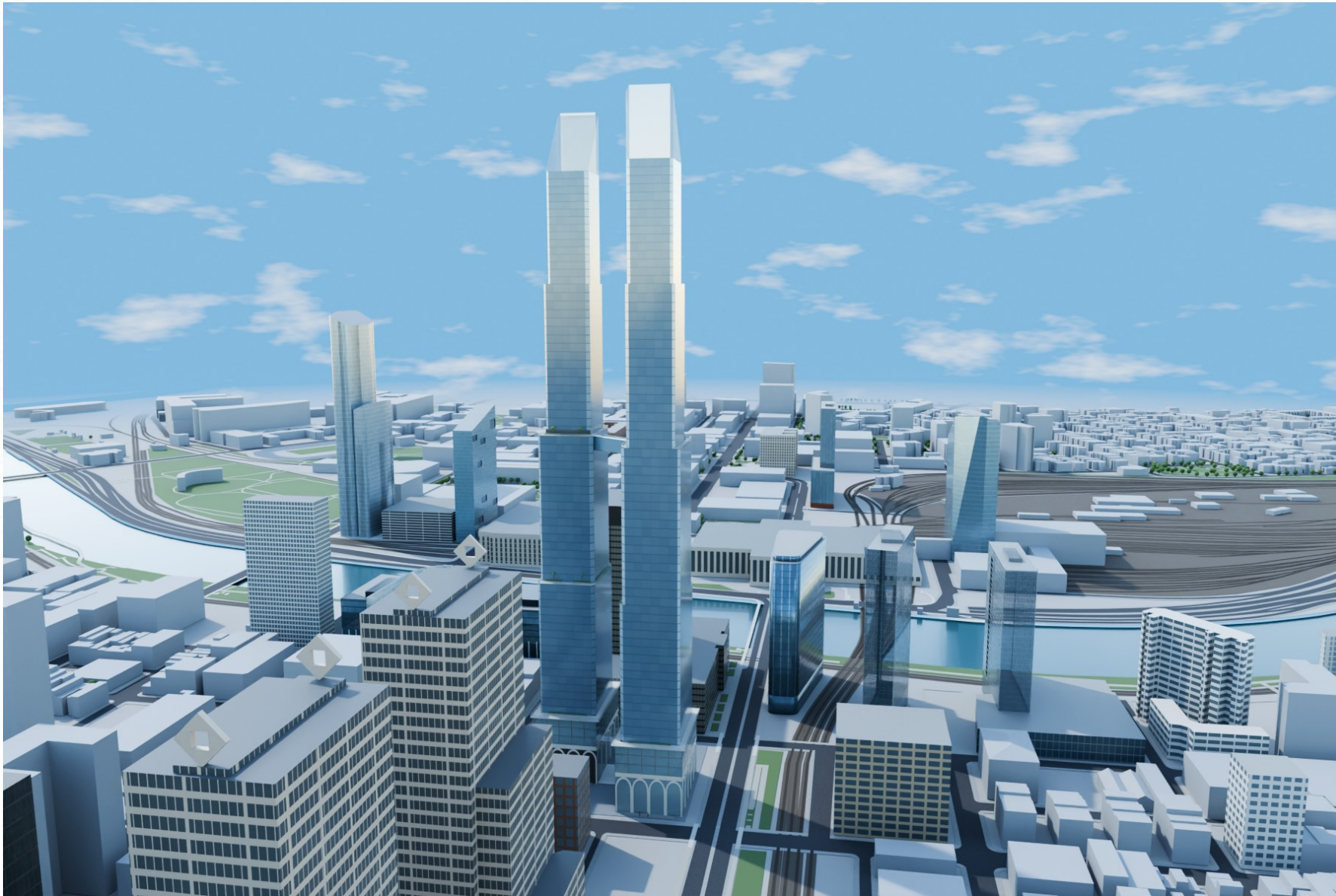
From the east, the proposal joins the skyline as another expression of Philadelphia's ambition - filling the gaps in its silhouette.

Design Scope

Millennium Towers by Bridge Solutions LLC is an independent design vision and proposal for 2201 Market Street, Philadelphia. Volume 1 explores its architecture and civic ambition.

Further development would address the existing PECO substation, utility operations and the relationship between infrastructure and the civic base.

Skyline studies use the project Blender model. Close views explore materials and atmosphere through assisted imagery. Surrounding city context is illustrative.
